



Roll-A-Ramp® installed at Buckingham Palace

More than the red carpet was rolled out at Buckingham Palace on 25th October this year when members of the Paralympics GB team attended a reception hosted by Her Majesty The Queen.

Roll-a-Ramp®, the revolutionary portable ramp system, was in use to ensure smooth, safe wheelchair and scooter access at the event, held a week after Paralympic Games medalists joined their Olympic counterparts in the Parade of Heroes through the streets of London. Among the 300 guests were athletes, sponsors' representatives and members of the support teams that made a vital contribution to the success of the British team in Athens. The Earl of Wessex, 2004 Patron of the British Paralympic Association and President of the Commonwealth Games Federation, also attended.



The two-tiered Roll-A-Ramp® allowed the Paralympic visitors along with elderly dignitaries to proceed into the Palace greeting area.
